

# Wee Tiny Mardi Gras Sock

## Materials:

- Fingering weight yarn\* in:
  - green
  - purple
  - yellow or gold
- Size 1 US double point needles

## Abbreviations:

CO – cast on      k – knit      m1 – make 1 increase  
sts – stitches      p – purl      m1p – make 1 purlwise  
sl – slip 1      k2tog – knit 2 stitches together

## Directions:

Using Green, CO 24 sts

Rnd 1: k1, p1  
Rnd 2: k1, p1  
Rnd 3: k1, p1  
Rnd 4: knit



## Leg:

Work Chart 1, knitting all stitches  
Knit one round in Green

## Divide for heel:

Rearrange stitches as follows:

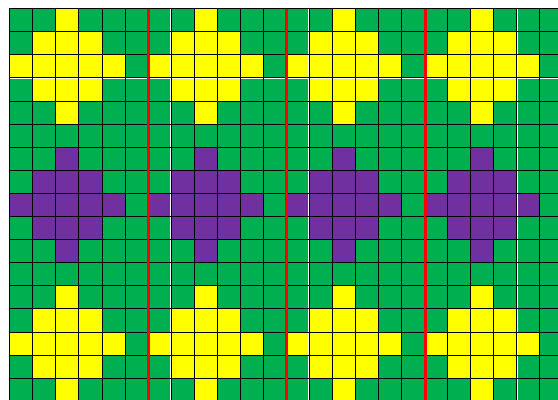
Needle 1: 12 sts (for heel)  
Needle 2: 6 sts  
Needle 3: 6 sts

## Work short row heel:

Using Purple, work heel on needle #1 as follows:

Row 1: slip 1, k10, turn  
Row 2: slip 1, p9, turn  
Row 3: slip 1, k8, turn  
Row 4: slip 1, p7, turn  
Row 5: slip 1, k6, turn  
Row 6: slip 1, p5, turn  
Row 7: slip 1, k4, turn  
Row 8: slip 1, p3, turn

Row 9: slip 1, k2, k2tog, m1, turn  
Row 10: slip 1, p3, p2tog, m1p, turn  
Row 11: slip 1, k4, k2tog, m1, turn  
Row 12: slip 1, p5, p2tog, m1p, turn  
Row 13: slip 1, k6, k2tog, m1, turn  
Row 14: slip 1, p7, p2tog, m1p, turn  
Row 15: slip 1, k8, k2tog, m1, turn  
Row 16: slip 1, p9, p2tog, m1p, turn

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## Foot:

Rearrange the stitches evenly among the three needles

Using Green, knit 9 rounds

## Toe:

Using Yellow, work toe

Rnd 1: knit

Rnd 2: k1, [k2tog, k4]x3, k2tog, k3 (20 sts)

Rnd 3: knit

Rnd 4: [k2tog, k3] around (16 sts)

Rnd 5: [k2tog, k2] around (12 sts)

Rnd 6: [k2tog, k1] around (8 sts)

Rnd 7: [k2tog] around (4 sts)

Break yarn, thread tail through remaining 4 stitches.

Weave in all ends.



## \*Notes/Materials Used

Green yarn: Knit Picks Bare Peruvian Highland Wool Fingering, dyed with Lemon Lime Kool-Aid

Yellow yarn: Knit Picks Bare Peruvian Highland Wool Fingering, dyed Yellow Sun Jacquard Acid Dye

Purple yarn: Pagewood Farms "Sock Bite" (I tried dyeing Bare with Grape Kool-Aid, but didn't like the resulting color)

Sock Blocker: The Mardi Gras Sock Wee Tiny Sock Blocker was custom ordered from bravelittleknitter's Etsy shop ([www.etsy.com/shop/bravelittleknitter](http://www.etsy.com/shop/bravelittleknitter))

If you are crafty with beading, you could make little Mardi Gras beads for your wee tiny sock.

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
